TRAVEL HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT LIMITS

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 26(6) of the Social Health Insurance Act, 2023, as read together with Regulation 70 (2) (b) of the Social Health Insurance Regulations, 2024, the Cabinet Secretary for Health gives notice that the minimum policy benefits for mandatory inbound travel health insurance shall be as specified in the Schedule below, provided that the cumulative policy benefit limit shall not be less than fifty thousand United States dollars (US\$ 50,000).

SCHEDULE

<i>S/No.</i>	<i>Policy Benefits</i>	<i>Insurable Limit in US\$</i>
1.	Medical expenses	20,000
2.	Emergency medical transportation	25,000
3.	Prescribed medicines	300
4.	Mental illness	1,000
5.	Repatriation of mortal remains	5,000

The mandatory inbound travel health insurance shall be provided by insurers approved and licensed under the Insurance Act, Cap. 487.
